

**JOINT

BREED HEALTH CO-ORDINATOR**

The Kennel Club are implementing 3-yearly terms for the above post. Applications are inviting from interested parties to apply for this role. The job role is as follows: -

- To be a vital conduit between The Kennel Club and breed clubs, owners & members of the public, and to be able to provide relevant advice and support.
- The ability to collate & disseminate significant, accurate & timely health research to The Kennel Club, breed clubs & owners.
- Motivate & educate owners, breed clubs & the public about relevant health issues within the breed.
- Recording & monitoring health issues throughout the breed via surveys, seminars, health reports & health testing sessions (when applicable) is a necessity in order to continuously evaluate & prioritise health problems within the breed.

Attributes & Skills as follows are required-

- Excellent Communication Skills & be approachable in order to communicate & convey appropriately with people of different levels.
- Impartial & maintains confidentiality regarding personal information supplied to them.
- Experience and enthusiastic about the breed & also motivated & resourceful for the benefit of the breed's health & welfare.
- Professional, have sound IT knowledge & excellent organisational skills.

Expectation from the clubs:-

- To provide a written health report to all the clubs, for presentation to the members at their AGMs. This is to be presented in layman's terms, for all members to be able to understand & digest. Ideally in a presentation format, i.e. PowerPoint, with visual displays.
- If any relevant information comes to light, to inform the secretary of all the breed clubs at the first possible opportunity.
- Any information that is required by the BHC, a suitable time (2 weeks) to be allowed for the Secretaries to be able to converse with their committees, and reply.
- To liaise with club health co-ordinators

Interested parties need to be able to attend relevant lectures and meetings which may be midweek.
